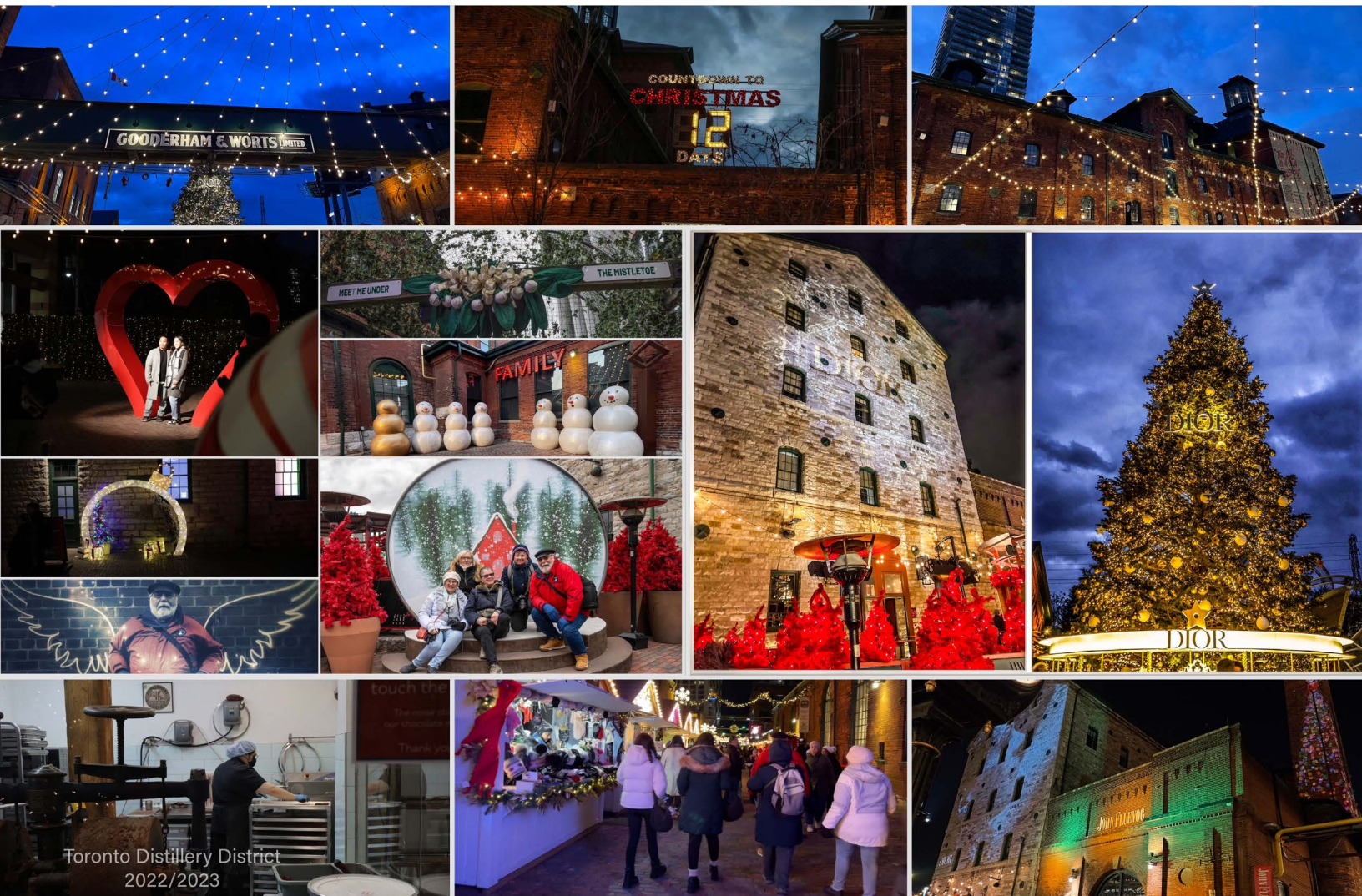

### DISTILLERY WINTER VILLAGE

Two years in a row, members of my Seniors Photo Club visited the Winter Village in the picturesque historic Distillery District of Toronto. The pedestrian-only cobblestone streets and the quaint 19<sup>th</sup> century buildings once housed a large whiskey distillery. Today, the buildings have been restored and it is home to a number of shops, restaurants, art galleries, and theatres.

From mid November through to early January, the district is transformed for the holiday season, decorated with lights and Christmas regalia including a 56-foot Christmas tree designed by Christian Dior Parfums. For the Christmas Market, there is a village of quaint kiosks serving up international foods and vendors selling unique gifts. It is especially charming after dark.

Besides the stunning Christmas tree, the Winter District provides a treasure trove of venues for capturing unique Christmas portraits. There are numerous holiday-themed frames and backdrops to capture that Instagram worthy shot!

# MEMBERS' CORNER

## RECIPE OF THE MONTH



### SHEPHERD'S PIE



#### Meat mixture

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 large sweet onion (chopped)
- 1½ lbs ground beef or lamb
- ½ teaspoon salt & pepper (or to taste)
- 1 clove garlic (minced)
- ½ teaspoon red pepper flakes
- 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- Pkg of dry onion soup mix (I use Knorr)
- 1 cup beef or vegetable broth
- 2 cups mixed frozen veggies (such as peas, carrots and corn)

#### Mashed potato topping:

- 6 large potatoes (peeled and cut into cubes)
- 4 tablespoons butter
- ½ cup milk
- ¼ cup cream cheese (optional)
- Salt & pepper to taste
- Parsley for garnish

1. Start by cooking the potatoes in boiling water until fork tender. While the potatoes are cooking, prepare the meat mixture.
2. Heat the oil in a large skillet or pot over medium heat. Add the onion and garlic and cook for a few minutes until the onion softens and becomes translucent.
3. Add the ground beef, season it with the salt and pepper and cook until it's no longer pink, breaking it up as you go along.
4. Next, add the pepper flakes, Worcestershire sauce, onion soup mix, beef broth and stir.
5. Stir in the frozen veggies and cook for a couple more minutes. Set aside.
6. Preheat the oven to 350°F.
7. Drain the potatoes then add them to a large bowl. Add the butter and mash until smooth. Add the milk, cheese (if using), salt, pepper and mash until smooth and creamy.
8. Place the meat mixture in a casserole.
9. Spread the potatoes over the meat and smooth it out with a spoon. Take a fork and rough up the top a bit.
10. Bake for 40 minutes or until light golden brown on top.
11. Garnish with parsley if desired and serve. Leftovers freeze well.

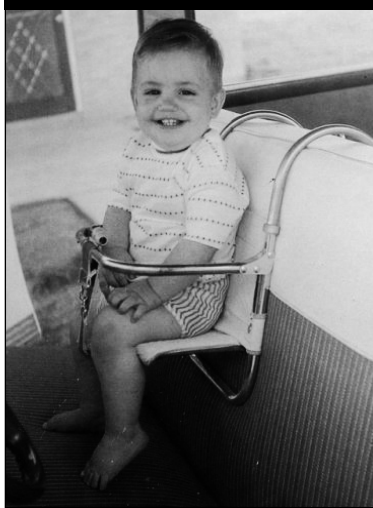

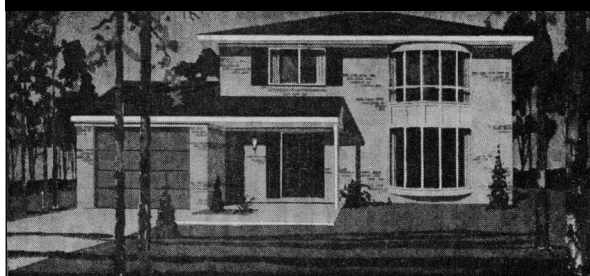
